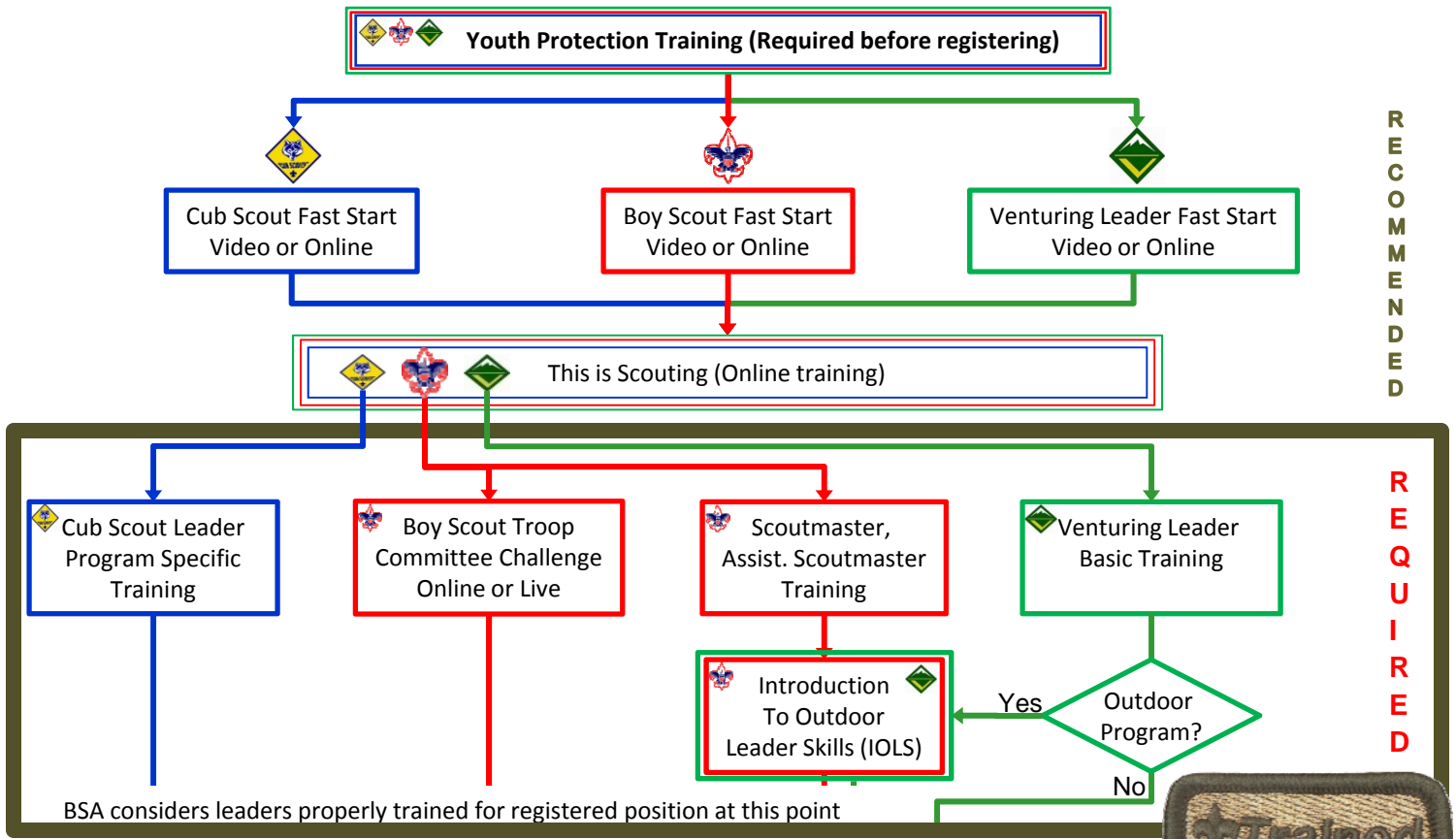


# BSA Leader Training Flowchart
